



Teacher Training Admission Requirements

1. Be at least 18 years of age.
2. Hold a high school diploma or its equivalent.
3. Submit a \$100 non-refundable application fee.
4. Complete application for admission
Application to the program does not guarantee acceptance. Candidates are evaluated for academic and physical ability, personal character, motivation and ability to manage time and meet financial obligations for tuition.
5. Have practiced yoga for at least one year.
6. Have completed at least 10 classes at TYP.

Certification and Registration

Our yoga teacher certification program fulfills the requirements necessary to become a Yoga Alliance (RYT200) Registered Yoga Teacher. Following graduation, students will be assisted in completing applications for registration.

Grading Scale

The following grading scale will be used:

- 90-100% Excellent
- 80-90% Met Standards
- 70-80% Average
- 60-70% Minimal effort
- Below 60% not qualified to graduate

To graduate, students must receive a combined grade of 60% or greater. The following will be graded:

- Class participation
- Exams
- Hands-on techniques
- Written and practical assignments
- Homework—timely completion
- Attendance
- How you contribute to the success of the group
- Holding your space as a community leader

Probation, Dismissal and Re-admittance

Students who have a cumulative grade below 60% will be considered on academic probation. Student has the option to complete an additional essay assigned by the director to be taken off of probation. Students who are on probation and don't come off after 1 month will be dismissed from the program without refund—options to rejoin future Teacher Training sessions will be considered.



Student's Records

Student records will be kept for a period of 7 years. Records are accessible to students by appointment only. Students may obtain transcripts by sending a \$20 fee with a request in writing.

Student Conduct

Students are required to follow all school rules, procedures and regulations. Students are also expected to behave in a professional manner at all times. Standards of conduct policies include, but are not limited to:

1. No sexual harassment of any type or form will be allowed.
2. No substance use or abuse during school hours will be accepted.
3. No smoking allowed on school property.
4. No breach of confidentiality will be tolerated.

Leaves of Absence

Due to medical disability, a leave of absence will be granted. In the event of a leave of absence, the student will have to reapply for the next available session and pay the difference, if any, of any remaining tuition.

Attendance and Tardiness

One hundred percent attendance is required. Any missed hours will have to be made up before graduation. All hours must be documented accurately. If the instructor has to spend time with the student to make up any information missed, the fee of \$45 per hour applies. Students who fail to hold make up sessions and or who fail to pay the fee will be dismissed.



Tardiness will not be tolerated and will result in dismissal. All classes will start on time and students are expected to be present and ready to participate. Students are required to notify the school if they intend to withdraw from the program. Any student who fails to attend a weekend intensive without communication is assumed withdrawn. Cancellation of classes due to weather may occur. It is the student's responsibility to call the school to get this information. Additional Saturdays, or weekends would be added near the end of the program if a cancellation is necessary.

Tuition, Fees and Refunds

Refunds:

1. The application fee is nonrefundable except in the case of denial acceptance.
2. Up until 2 weeks before start of program, student may receive a 90% refund if cancellation is necessary.
3. No refunds 2 weeks prior to program or after start of training.
4. Students will receive their refund within 60 days after notification of withdrawal.
